

History

The WFSOS was established in London in 1992 as the non-commercial non-governmental organization consisting of 35 national organizations dealing with:

- applying effective collective measures against the oncological diseases all over the world;
- developing friendly relations among specialists of different countries on the basis of the only one professional sphere;
- carrying out international cooperation;
- promoting consolidation of surgeons-oncologists efforts in achieving common aims.

When WFSOS started with 12 different countries and the first joint meeting, was with the SSO in SAN DIEGO

Meetings were held every 2 years

- Now we gather 36 different countries and we look for 3 or 4 joint meetings each year.**
- National Societies could reach membership for free.**
- Individual member could pay a symbolic fee(10\$, and free participation at meetings, Journal and pass for website.**
